Tylenol or Ibuprofen Permission Form  
2019-2020 School Year**

The Board of Trustees of Odyssey Community School allows the school nurse to dispense Tylenol (or its generic form) or Ibuprofen under Standing Orders written by OCS's medical advisor and with the written permission of the parent or guardian. These Standing Orders allow Tylenol or Ibuprofen to be given for:

1. Headache without injury or fever;
2. Menstrual cramps; and
3. Recent dental work

Only one dose of Tylenol or Ibuprofen will be given during a school day. If the student continues to have a problem, the parent will be notified that a medical evaluation is needed before any more medication will be dispensed.

Regular Tylenol or Ibuprofen or junior strength can be dispensed to students in grades 3 through 8. If you wish your child to be given Tylenol or Ibuprofen as indicated in the Standing Orders, please complete this form and sign below.
